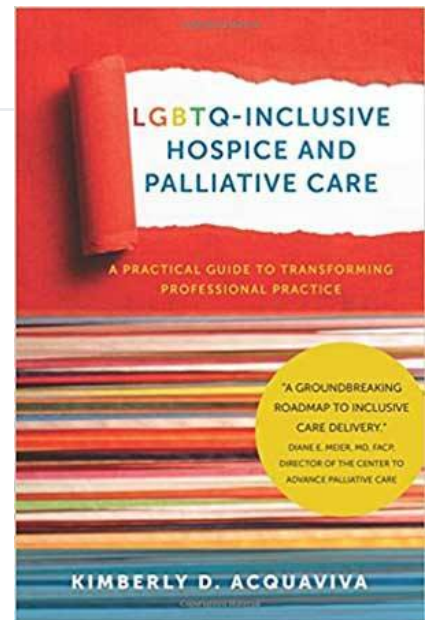


LGBTQ-Inclusive Hospice and Palliative Care: A Practical Guide to Transforming Professional Practice
